

TUITION WAIVERS FOR 2010/11 - Need and Merit

SDA Bocconi School of Management is making available to 2010/2011 MPM candidates with an outstanding profile:
13 partial tuition fee waivers:

- 2 tuition fee waivers equal to 5,000 euro for Italian citizens
- 3 tuition fee waivers equal to 5000 euro for European citizens (Italy excluded)
- 2 tuition fee waivers equal to 5000 euro for citizens of the Americas
- 4 tuition fee waivers equal to 5000 euro for citizens from Asia/Middle East/Australia Oceania
- 2 tuition fee waivers equal to 5000 euro for citizens of African countries

1. Beneficiaries and Requirements

Tuition waivers are available to students with an outstanding personal, academic and professional CV only and they should meet the following requirements:

- Excellent academic profile
- Be a citizen of one of the countries of origin or continents mentioned above

Only candidates who have regularly applied (On-line application) and produced all required documentation (University degree and transcripts, Toefl or Ielts, GMAT/GRE, Reference letters, CV, photos) within the deadlines indicated on the MPM website, and have been admitted to the 2010/11 MPM Program are eligible for tuition waivers.

2. Incompatibility and Assignment of Tuition Waivers

The tuition waiver cannot be accumulated with any other scholarship, award or financial support for specialization courses by public or private organisations or companies. The beneficiaries must self-certify the absence of the above-mentioned accumulation. The right to the tuition waiver is subject to the regular completion of the 2010/11 MPM program as indicated in the MPM Rules.

3. Lodging of Applications and Results

Applications for the tuition waiver must be sent by one of the two deadlines **April 30th** and **June 12th 2010*** to:

Tuition fee waiver applications must include:

- Tuition Waiver Application Form (available on the MPM website)
- Motivation Letter (the letter should demonstrate the candidate's strong interest in the Public Sector, i.e. through previous professional experience)

and should be sent to the school together with the documents required for admission to MPM. The assignment of the tuition waiver will be formally notified to the beneficiary by the Commission through an assignment letter, by no later than July 31st 2010.

4. Acceptance of the conditions

Application for the tuition waiver involves full acceptance of the herein conditions. Under penalty of immediate withdrawal, the candidates must confirm their enrolment in the 2010/11 MPM as well as formalize their acceptance of all tuition waiver conditions with the Admissions office by the deadline indicated on the tuition waiver assignment letter.
