

NOTICE OF COMPETITION
FOR THE AWARDING OF 1 SCHOLARSHIP
FOR POSTGRADUATE SPECIALIZATION COURSE

**“UCINA Italian Marine Industry Association
in memory of Lorenzo Selva, Vice President”**

ART. 1

Given the liberal contribution offered by the *UCINA – Italian Marine Industry Association*, in memory of Mr Lorenzo Selva prematurely departed in June 2012, SDA Bocconi School of Management announces the competition for the awarding of 1 scholarship worth 20.000 Euro, available to applicants to the Master of Business Administration Program 2013/2014 organized and promoted by SDA Bocconi School of Management.

ART. 2

Only candidates with the following pre-requisites are eligible to apply for the awarding of the scholarship announced in this competition:

- They have a GMAT score not lower than 650
- They have proven experience in nautical sports.

ART. 3

The Scholarship Application Forms must reach the Admissions Office of SDA Bocconi, Masters Division, Via Balilla 18 – 20136 Milano, Italy, within **April 30th, 2013**.

ART. 4

Consideration will be given only to applicants who have submitted a regular Application for Admission to the MBA 2013/2014 Course together with the required documentation and a motivation letter. To be eligible for the scholarship candidates must have obtained admission to the MBA 2013/2014 Program.

ART. 5

The judging panel will consist of members appointed by *SDA Bocconi* and *UCINA*. The following criteria will be used in evaluating the applications:

- analysis of academic and professional record;
- results of MBA course selection tests
- results of any interviews which may be requested at the discretion of the judging panel.

ART. 6

The panel's decision will be considered final. The assignment of the scholarship will be formally notified to the beneficiary by the Commission through an assignment letter, no later than the starting date of the 2013/14 MBA. Failure to accept the scholarship, as well as failure to enroll in the MBA Full Time 2013/2014 Program by the date stated in the notification letter, would determine the loss of the scholarship.

ART. 7

The winner of the scholarship is required to carry out a Project with a Nautical Focus. This project is additional to the Summer Project required by the MBA Program.

ART. 8

Tenure of the scholarship will be for the duration of the MBA Program. Payment will occur in accordance with the dates and conditions provided by the judging panel on assignment, subject to the regular completion of the 2013/14 MBA program by the winner.

ART. 9

Tenure of the scholarship does not constitute any form of subordinated employment by the SDA Bocconi School of Management and excludes social security and welfare contributions of any kind. The stated amount of the scholarship shall be intended gross of taxes, if any is due, under the current Italian or the winner's residency country tax laws.

ART. 10

The scholarship can be combined with any other scholarship, award, or financial support for specialization courses by public or private organisations or companies if the total amount does not exceed the total registration fee.

The winner must self-certify that the above-mentioned accumulation has not been exceeded.

The winner must comply with this condition for the whole duration of the MBA Program.

ART. 11

Application for the scholarship announced in this competition involves full acceptance of the herein conditions.
