Biography

Valentina Mele is an Associate Professor at Università Bocconi and Associate Professor at SDA Bocconi School of Management. At SDA Bocconi she has been head of and professor in several courses including Public Governance, Business-government Relations, Corporate Citizenship, International Organizations and the Management of International Development. She has taught participants of Executive programs in business, in public management and health and international organizations.

Her research activities focus on organization and technological innovation in public organizations; governance and business-government relations; corporate citizenship and cross-sector partnerships; international governance and international organizations. Her work has been published in high impact journals including the Journal of Public Administration Research and Theory, Public Administration, Governance, the International Public Management Journal, the Academy of Management Journal, the Journal of Business Ethics and Public Management Review among others. Valentina has received several competitive individual grants including the Fulbright studentship and scholarship, the CNR study grant, the CNR short-term mobility grant, and several awards including the Award for excellence in research at Bocconi (7 times), the International Geneva Award (2011 and 2015) and the Best Published Paper, OMT Academy of Management (2016).

She serves as Field Editor for the Journal of Public Policy (Cambridge University Press) and she is an editorial board member of Public Administration Review and Governance. She has been a member of the Sustainability Advisory Board, European Aluminium Association and she serves on the Sustainability Board Committee of a company listed on the Milan stock market. Valentina earned an MSc in Economics and Management of Government & International Organizations from Università Bocconi, a Master in Public Policy & Administration from Columbia University and a PhD in Management from the London School of Economics.
