Massimo Morelli è Professore di Political Science and Economics presso l'Università Bocconi. È Fellow della Society for the Advancement of Economic Theory, Fellow della Econometric Society, Research Fellow presso il Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR), l'Istituto Gasparini per le Ricerche Economiche (IGIER) e il Baffi Carefin Center. È inoltre direttore dell'unità Pericles. Prima di entrare a far parte dell'Università Bocconi, è stato Professore di Political Science and Economics presso la Columbia University dal 2007 al 2014.

I suoi interessi di ricerca spaziano dalla teoria dei giochi, al design dei meccanismi, all'economia politica, alle istituzioni di governance, all'economia dello sviluppo, all'economia comportamentale e pubblica, alla politica comparata e alle relazioni internazionali. È autore di numerosi articoli sui suoi argomenti di interesse, pubblicati, tra gli altri, nel *Journal of Economic Geography*, nel *Journal of Economic Behavior and Organization* e nell'*American Journal of Political Science*.
