Valeria Giacomini è Assistant Professor presso il Dipartimento di Social and Political Sciences dell'Università Bocconi. In precedenza ha svolto incarichi di ricerca post-dottorato presso la Harvard Business School e la Marshall Business School (USC).

La sua ricerca si concentra sulla storia globale dei mercati delle materie prime nel Sud-est asiatico; i cluster in prospettiva storica; e la storia aziendale dei mercati emergenti dal XIX secolo. Recentemente ha avviato nuovi progetti sull'imprenditorialità storica e gli ecosistemi imprenditoriali in contesti storici e geografici diversi. Il suo lavoro è stato pubblicato in riviste come Business History, Enterprise & Society, MOH, Journal of Global History e Journal of Business Ethics.

Ha conseguito il Dottorato di ricerca presso la Copenhagen Business School con una tesi sullo sviluppo del cluster dell'olio di palma nel Sud-est asiatico dall'epoca coloniale ad oggi.
