When thinking about startups, it comes to mind a basement in the Silicon Valley, where a group of hard-working people managed to turn an idea into a successful business venture. In particular, the main topics discussed will be: business planning, business scale-up, funding and exit strategies. To wrap up, we will discuss why entrepreneurial figures are rare to encounter in large corporations.
